

Boat Check Information

Friday – From 4pm to 6pm:

Anglers can come to the trailer and check in. Check in means getting their key fob boat number and getting their boat checked. Flagging tape will be tied onto their trolling motor which identifies them at tournament anglers and represents that their boat has been checked.

Saturday Morning Check in until 6:30am:

There will be a table set up near the boat ramp. Boaters need to stop at the table and get their key fob boat number. They will also get their boat check while in line to launch their boat.

After 6:30 am any boater who has not checked in or does not have their boat check will go to the end of the line and take off after all the other anglers have left.

Random checks of fishing license and insurance will be done.

Saturday Afternoon Check In Procedure:

Boaters returning to the dock for weigh in will need to give their assigned key fob boat number to the check in person standing at the dock. The boat is not checked in until that person has the key fob returned.
