Qualifiers Guaranteed 1st Place - \$1000 (Minimum of 20 teams) Entry Fee: \$175.00 per Team, which includes Big Bass entry. (1 place paid for each 10 teams entered) Championship Guaranteed 1st Place - \$1500 (Minimum of 20 teams)

Entry Fee: \$200.00 per Team, which includes Big Bass entry. (1 place paid for each 10 teams entered)

Texas B.A.S.S. Nation is pleased to offer its membership another path to qualify for the BASSMASTER CLASSIC. Texas Bassmaster Team Trail Championship Qualification is simple:

- > All contestants must be a member in good standing with BASS Nation (National).
- > ALL teams that compete in at least three of the five qualifiers will be qualified for the 2022 TBTT Championship.
- > It the responsibility of each contestant to read, understand and abide by applicable tournament rules.
- Online registration is available through the Wednesday prior to the event. Mail in registrations must be postmarked 10 days prior to the event. Onsite registration is available at the official take off location from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm the day before the event.
- Scoring for all events are based on a points system where first place earns 200 points, second place 199 points, third place 198 points and so on.
- Slot limits apply on some lakes:
 - o On lakes where Statewide Rules are in place the minimum legal length is 14".
 - On lakes where slot limits are in place, bass below and above the slot may be presented at weigh-in.
- Qualifying tournaments are one-day events where places are paid based on the numbers of teams entered in the event.
 One place will be paid for every 10 teams registered.
- > The Texas BASS Nation Team Championship is a two-day event, where the highest finishing team will earn the berth to the BASS Nation Team Championship Event. One place will be paid for every 10 teams registered.
- > All Team member(s) are required to be at the mandatory angler check in and angler meeting @ 5:00 pm the day prior to the scheduled tournament.
- > During this event all anglers will follow Covid-19 social distancing protocols.
- The BASSMASTER Team Championship is an entry-fee based National two-day event, where the top three (3) teams advance to the BASSMASTER Team Classic Event, which will be held the same week, following the BASSMASTER Team Championship. BASSMASTER will provide six (6) boats, whereby each individual will then compete. There is no entry fee to the final Classic Event, and no Payouts. The Champion wins a 2021 BASSMASTER CLASSIC entry.
